



## 2024 Impact Report

It's been a fabulous year! Nearly 9 years into our 'little project' with the mission to increase children's experiences with language, literacy, and human interactions ... and we're making a difference in so many lives... one book and one book bag at a time!

Some of the best KNOWN ways to help children to have "better tomorrows" is to:

- increase the number of books in the home (the more the better);
- · surround children with and offer them rich language experiences; and
- foster more interactions between children and their parents/caregivers.

In 2024, PoWeR! Book Bags, with help from YOU and other dedicated volunteers, donors, and grantors, delivered:

- +Over 100,000 brand new books &
- +Nearly 16,000 PoWeR! Literacy Bags into the hands of
- +Over 20,000 children
- +Across 27 counties!

In all, since we've begun, you've helped us to deliver over 600,000 books and 100,000 book bags into the hearts, hands, and homes of primarily underserved children throughout Michigan.

For our young friends, ages 0-5, every single book and PoWeR! Literacy Bag that goes into a home provides the families with tools and opportunities for increasing exposure to more language, deepening the early relationships between children and their families AND growing MINDS. This is a busy time when 90% of brain growth occurs, setting the stage for the rest of the child's life. With access to materials and interactions, children can thrive.

For our older friends in elementary schools and above, our materials provide them with opportunties to practice growing skills with written language at home. When children have access to writing materials and books that they've selected, they are much more eager to write and read, developing the VERY necessary skills to be literate while growing a LOVE for literacy that will help them be more successful throughout life.
